2.2.4. IPR management *(project description)*



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- In the context of the public health emergency, the CO-VERSATILE **partners acknowledge the exploitation obligations and will ensure that the project's services and products will be available and accessible**, as soon as possible and at fair conditions. In this sense, the results of CO-VERSATILE will be exploited by the partners and made available to other relevant EU industries and initiatives in line with the exploitation strategy depicted above and the table below represents the ownership and tentative IP that will be generated by the developed CO- VERSATILE solutions.



Knowledge management and protection measure



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The management of knowledge and IPR will be ruled by the Consortium Agreement (CA) that will implement and complete Grant Agreement regulations defining the distribution of EU funds and Intellectual Property Rights protection. The CA will be signed by all the partners before the start of the project and will take into account the following preliminary agreements: Background knowledge to the purposes of the project will be specified in the CA and will be made available to consortium members on a royalty-free basis whether necessary to perform project activities. **Foreground knowledge is owned by the contractor generating such information or result.** Each contractor shall make available its foreground knowledge, on a royalty-free basis, to other contractors to the extent that such information is necessary for the production of their own foreground knowledge within CO-VERSATILE. **If it is not possible to determine exactly the ownership of that foreground knowledge, i.e. several contractors participated in that specific development, ownership will be shared among the contributing contractors in equal parts by the pro ratio effort invested by each contractor.** **Background and foreground knowledge will be made available:** (i) to the other project **partners** for dissemination, research, demonstration, interoperability of software and academic purposes in respect to the intellectual property rights of the partner generating this knowledge, on a royalty-free basis; (ii) for exploitation and replication purposes to other project partners and other external entities the licences will be made on a non-exclusive basis and at fair and reasonable conditions, with respect to the normal commercial conditions applied by the granting partner. The CA will also make explicit reference to important administrative points such as decision procedures within the project, risk management strategies, legal aspects regarding software to be used/produced in the project, trademarks, patents and rights of each partner in the exploitation of results. **Finally, a Results Ownership List (ROL) will be submitted in M24 of the project.**

The **Results Ownership List (ROL)** will show on how the project results are expected to be replicated and exploited through commercial or industrial exploitation, how they will be protected and how joint ownership will be managed with an emphasis on IP exploitation that is required for the replication and exploitation strategy of tasks 4.2 and 4.3.



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The Results Ownership List (ROL)

Definition of the ROL



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The Result Ownership List (deliverable D6.3/M24) will be the final result and achievement of Milestone (Ms10). The ROL is a list offering a consolidated view of the results of the Project which will illustrate the foreground information, what has been achieved and produced over the course of the Co-Versatile Project by partners. It will be delivered in a tabular form , and it will contain also an explanatory text to the 25 topics which compose the ROL (they also include references to IPR related issues, access, further re-use, and intended final users and the expected exploitation) and additionally an introductory statement describing the ROL. For the production of ROL it was necessary that the partners reached a consensus on how the results would be exploited and the IPR ensured (ongoing activity).

Upon the basis of the consolidated view offered by the ROL Partners can then initiate exploitation activities according to the chosen business model.

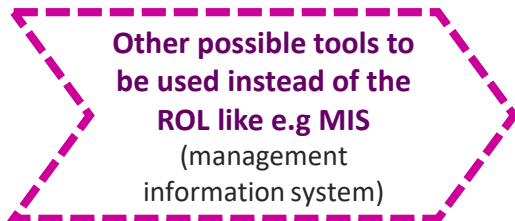
- Up to now the ROL recognizes 24 official results
- The List of Results Property, **delivered in the tabular form**, illustrates what has been achieved and produced over the course of the Co-versatile project.
- Its elaboration results from all the measures established and deployed since the beginning of the project

- The **Consortium Agreement (CA)** was a further important instrument in the process of conceiving the ROL. It **set out the governance parameters in relation to Knowledge Management and IPR**, defining the distribution of EU funds and Intellectual Property Rights protection.

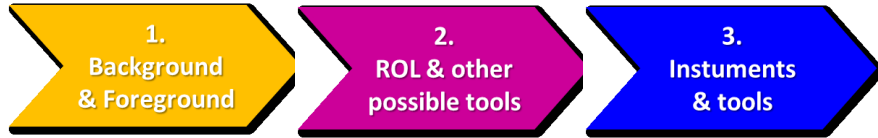

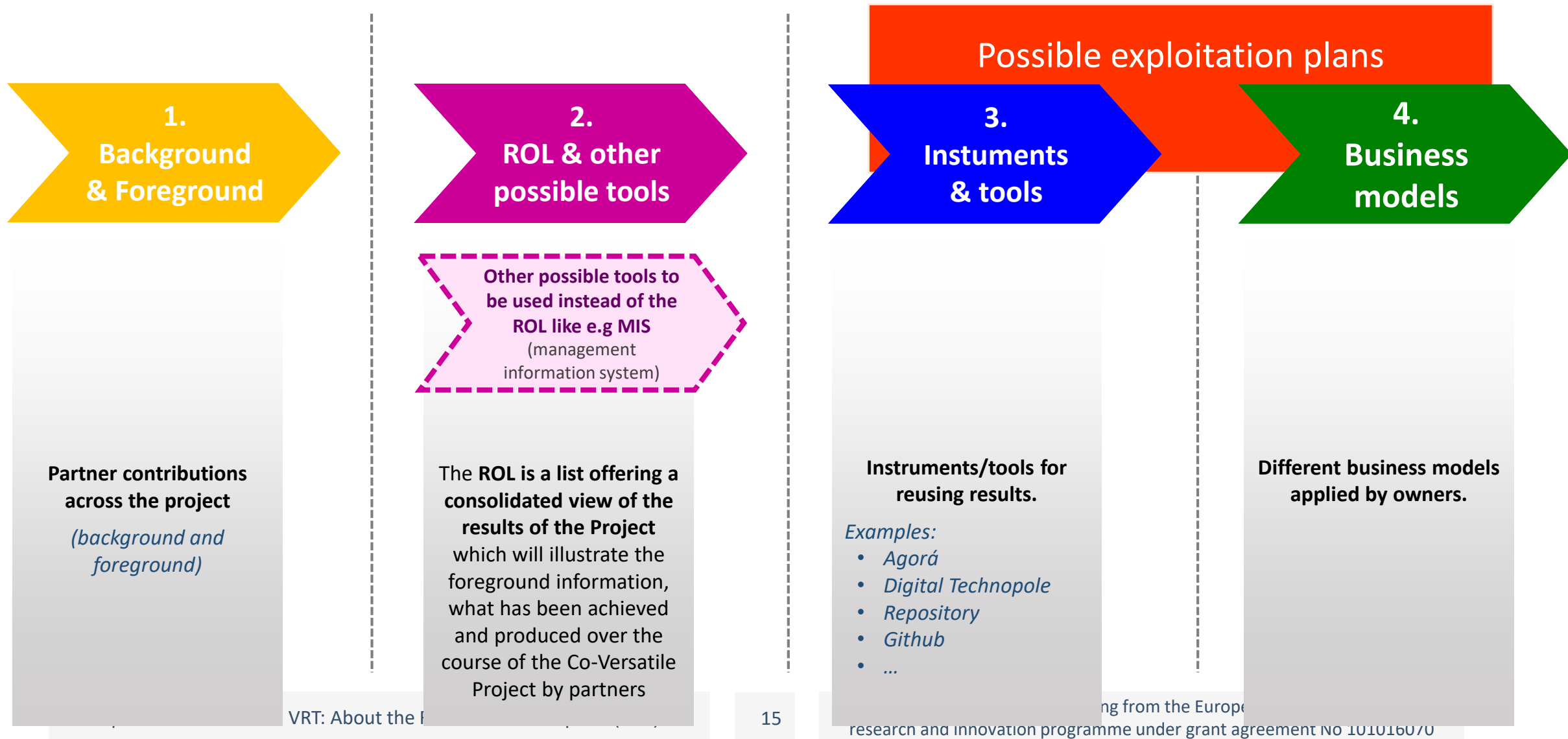
